Basic requirements for exporting companies

- Make sure that your company
 - ✓ complies with national and EU laws
 - ✓ is a registered/approved food establishment in Finland
 (→<u>contact your local food control authority</u>)
 - ✓ finds out the requirements of the destination countries and fulfils them
- Companies are always responsible for the safety of the food products they sell. This also applies to situations where products you sell do not pass through you.



Japan – general information

- Food safety authorities in Japan:
 - <u>Animal Quarantine Service, Ministry of Agriculture,</u> <u>Forestry and Fisheries (MAFF)</u>
 - Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare (MHLW)
- Products exported from Finland to Japan, e.g. dairy products, pork meat, confectionery, malt, grain and flour, fish products, alcohol products and berry products
- Country approvals needed for meat and eggs:
 - Finland has approval for pork and poultry meat, eggs and egg products
 - Approval process ongoing for beef





Japan – product specific requirements 1/2

- Pork and poultry meat
 - Each exporting establishment must be approved by Japanese authorities prior export
 - Specific veterinary health certificate must be used; Animal Health Requirements
- Eggs and egg products
 - Specific veterinary health certificate used for table eggs and egg products must be used
- Milk and milk products
 - Specific certificate model for milk and milk products must be used updated certificate! Animal Health Requirements
- Fishery products
 - No specific certificate model agreed between Finland and Japan





Japan – product specific requirements 2/2

- MHLW requires that imported berries and mushrooms are analysed for radioactivity:
 - Analysis is required for each batch of mushrooms, dried mushrooms and dried mushroom products as well as concentrated berry products
 - Analysis is required for the first import batch of berries and other berry products than concentrated berry products.
- Deer meat and products (reindeer, moose)
 - Export of deer meat and products is not possible due to a TSE-diagnosed moose found in 2018 in Finland.



Market entry handbook: Japan

- MHLW recommends conducting an import exercise with the relevant MHLW Quarantine Station prior export, especially when shipping new or unknown products to Japan
- Regulations, e.g. (unofficial translations at http://www.japaneselawtranslation.go.jp/law):
 - Food Safety Basic law
 - The Food Sanitation Act & specifications and standards for foods, food additives, etc. under this Act
 - Domestic Animal Infectious Diseases Control Act
 - Plant Protection Act
 - The Health Promotion Act
 - Food Labelling Act
 - The Law Concerning Standardization, etc. of Agricultural and Forestry Products' (the JAS Law)

National registers for exporters

- FFA Official register of exporters
 - Exporters who commercially export animal products or live animals outside EU have to register into an official register of exporters on <u>FFA's webpage</u>
 - Registration is not a permit for export
 - Registration is a prerequisite for getting a veterinary health certificate for export
- Plant health register
 - Exporters who regularly export products requiring a phytosanitary certificate have to register into a plant health register on <u>FFA's webpage</u>



Export certificates (1/2)

- Importing country sets requirements for export certificates. It is important to find out the requirements in advance
- Certificates of free sale
 - Required often for products of plant origin
 - Issued by the local food control authority
 - FFA has made <u>a general model</u> that can be modified
- Phytosanitary certificates
 - Typically required when exporting plants, grain, fruits, berries, vegetables etc.
 - Usually not required for processed plant products
 - <u>Issued by FFA</u>, must be ordered at least two weeks before the product is exported





Export certificates (2/2)

- Veterinary health certificates:
 - Typically required when exporting animals or products of animal origin from Finland to countries outside EU
 - Issued by an official veterinarian controlling the place of loading
 - Issued before the consignment leaves
 - Options:
 - Agreed certificate models (EU/Finland and the importing country)
 - <u>General veterinary health certificate</u> models made by FFA for certain products
 - Other certificates
- Valvira issues export certificates for alcoholic products











Finnish Food Authority as an enabler of exports

- We provide information, guidance and training about exports and export requirements for companies and control authorities.
- We promote the exports of food chain products from Finland to countries outside the EU by opening new markets and securing existing exports.
 - Cooperation with authorities in destination countries regarding animal diseases and food safety, and hosting visits and audits
 - ✓ Resolving acute export problems
 - ✓ Actions to enter markets, e.g. market access questionnaires
 - Export control systems (China, Eurasia, the USA)
 - Draft and management of veterinary health certificates
- We **work in cooperation** with other export authorities and bodies to support the internationalisation of Finnish companies.
